Personal data is **collected**:

- Directly from the individual - by voluntarily uploading a video and entering personal data via the SEND D web and/or mobile application to a protected location or
- Directly from the individual - exceptionally, by voluntarily transmitting videos to other channels chosen by parents/guardians

The processing includes the following **categories of subjects and categories of personal data**:

- natural person – child



- name and surname of the child
- date of birth
- planned date of birth (in case of premature birth)
- video of the child
- quality classification (analysis) of the child's movements
- diagnosis/finding/description of movements
- biometric features of the child visible in the video (eye color, birthmark...)
- discharge letter from the maternity hospital
- as necessary, other relevant medical documentation

Storage and transfer of personal data

Personal data will be stored on a server in a certified data center (e.g. ISO/IEC 27001 (Enterprise cloud services) certified or equivalent) selected for the functioning of the web and/or mobile application.

Personal data will not be transferred to third countries.

The security of the processing of personal data will be ensured by the implementation of appropriate technical and organizational measures and procedures in a way that ensures the protection of the rights of the respondents and which is always by the currently valid legislation in the field of personal data protection. Withdrawal of consent
